Funding Opportunities

SPRITE+ offers funding for:

1. Funding Academic **Secondments** within partner organisation
 - Up to five Expert Fellow Secondments (up to £50,000 in total): partnerships between academics and non-academic organisations.
 - Typical duration: 4–6 weeks secondments with potential for follow-on projects.
 - Travel & subsistence or academic buyout time.
 - Matched academic-industry partners submit a short proposal after the event which is quick, focused, and impact-driven.
2. Funding is available to support exploratory post-event visits between Expert Fellows, PhD students, and organisations. SPRITE+ provides funding for academics to visit organisations to explore potential research collaborations. The funding covers reasonable expenses associated with **one UK round-trip** and, if necessary, **1 night accommodation costs**. Visits must take place by **31 July 2026**.
